

Soroptimist's *Live Your Dream: Education and Training Awards for Women* annually disburses nearly \$1.9 million in education grants to more than 1,300 women who have overcome enormous personal obstacles. Recipients may use the cash grants to offset any costs associated with their efforts to attain additional education or training. Award recipients go on to enjoy improved employment prospects, greater earning potential, higher self-esteem, and serve as positive role models for their children.

Dream It, Be It: Career Support for Girls, Soroptimist's newest program, provides girls with tangible strategies to accomplish their career goals.
